NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL WORKS A14 J9-J10 Drainage renewals

I'm writing to let you know that we'll be carrying out essential drainage works on the A14 between Junction 9 and Junction 10, works will be carried out in both directions in separate phases.

During our scheme of work, we'll

- Clear vegetation
- Repair and replace existing drainage infrastructure including installation of new filter drains.

Once completed, all road users will benefit from improved road safety and will provide relief to the existing highways system.

When will the work take place?

Work is due to start 27 March 2023 and is scheduled for completion in June 2023.

During the first 3 weeks of our works, we will mainly be clearing vegetation. This will involve clearing a 6m section from the carriageway to allow visibility for signs, slip road and also to expose the drainage. We will also be cutting back trees.

We will also be excavating and installing new sign foundations and carrying out work to the existing drainage system.

Please note that all our planned roadworks may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

How will the work affect traffic?

To keep our programme for these works as short as possible and to minimise disruption to the local community, residents, businesses and road users we'll work **Monday** to **Friday, 8pm** until **6am**

The works will be carried out under a full carriageway closure which includes slip roads. We'll also have 1 lane closure on the opposite carriageway with a 50 mph speed restriction in place.

During these closures fully signed diversion routes will be in place, which have been agreed with the Local Authority.

How will the work affect businesses and residents?

We'll make sure that access to businesses and residences is maintained wherever possible.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused and will do our very best to complete this essential maintenance work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.
